<p>Grade 1</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • pencils • erasers (pencil top) • markers (non-scented, washable) • crayons (no large boxes please) • 5 plastic two-pocket folders – labeled with child’s name and subjects (Spanish, Social Studies, Science, Writing, Homework) • 1 composition notebook for math • 1 small case to hold supplies, please no large boxes as they do not fit in the cubbies • 1 art smock (can be old long sleeve shirt) • 1 binder (1") labeled with child's name on the spine with 25 sheet protectors inserted <p><i>Please label all items with your child's name.</i></p>	<p>Grade 2</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • 1 two-pocket homework folder • 1 one-subject notebook for Math • pencils (no. 2) • erasers (pencil top—please refrain from novelty erasers, these don’t work well and they can be a distraction) • markers (non-scented, washable) • crayons and/or colored pencils (no large boxes please, they are a storage problem) • 1 small case to hold supplies that will fit into cubby • 1 sketchbook 8 ½” x 11” for art • 1 two-pocket folder for Spanish <p><i>Please label all items with your child's name.</i></p>
<p>Grade 3</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • 4 two-pocket folders (labeled: Home, Science, Work-in-Progress, Spanish) • 2 one-subject spiral notebooks (Science, Weekend News) • 1 binder (1") for Spanish with 5-piece divider set and loose-leaf, lined paper • 1 binder (1") with pockets and clear view cover for writing portfolio • 1 binder (3") D-ring with clear view cover for work portfolio with 4 dividers labeled: math, science, language arts, social studies • 20-25 clear view sleeves (sheet protectors) for inside writing binder (extended edge/3-hole punched) • pencils (No. 2) and pencil BAG, zippered • glue sticks and cap erasers • ballpoint pen for correcting (any color) • colored pencils and crayons, no large boxes • highlighter - yellow • a flash drive is recommended, but not mandatory • 3 jumbo size book socks • 1 sketchbook 8 ½” x 11” for art 	<p>Grade 4</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • 4 two-pocket folders (Homework, Science Class, Science Fair, Spanish) • 2 one-subject spiral notebooks (Science, Social Studies) • 1 binder (1”) for Spanish with a 5-piece divider set and loose-leaf, lined paper • 1 binder (1½") with clearview cover for writing portfolio • 1 binder (3") D-ring with clearview cover for work portfolio with a 8-piece divider set • 1 binder (½") for Music – white in color with loose leaf paper, pencil holder and pencils • 50 page protectors (plastic sleeves with 3 holes) for writing portfolio • pencils (No. 2) and erasers • glue sticks • a flash drive is recommended, but not mandatory • 3-4 jumbo size book sox for hardcover books • 1 sketchbook 8 ½” x 11” for art <p><i>Please label all items with your child's name.</i></p>

Grade 5

Grades 6 - 8

1 three-subject, Neat-Sheet spiral notebook

colored pencils (optional)
1 binder (1/2") with clear front pocket on the cover

Science:
1 Neat-Sheet spiral notebook with pockets
1 marble composition book

Art:
1 sketchbook 8 ½" x 11"

Students taking Spanish Only:
1 Neat Sheet spiral notebook
1 1.5" binder with 4 tab dividers, wide ruled loose leaf
Larousse's Student Dictionary (not pocket kind)

Students taking Spanish and Learning Skills:

1 binder (1 ½") with 5-piece divider set and loose-leaf, lined paper
1 pack notecards
Larousse's Student Dictionary (not pocket kind)

Students taking Learning Skills Only:

1 two-pocket folder

1 highlighter
1 black erasable pen
